What will you receive?

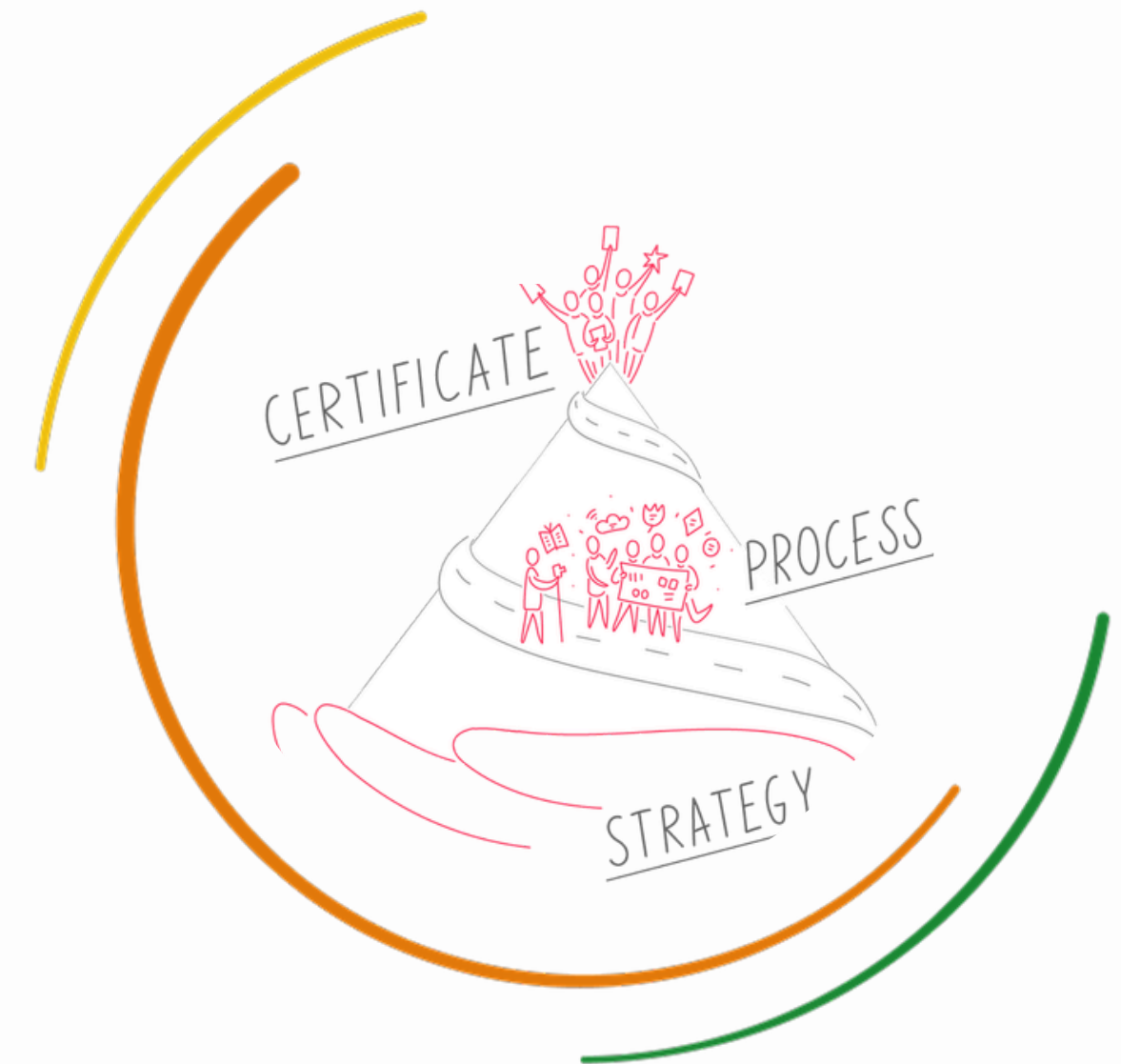
- Coverage of travel, accommodation, food, and pocket money. Full health and liability insurance
